

## **The campaign exchange**

**The idea is to bring campaigners together in mutual support, to spread awareness of campaign causes and use 'strength in numbers' to lever political change.**

- **Campaigners pay an annual fee of £10 - £20 to join the website. This covers the cost of running the site.**
- **All campaigns must pass an ethical test to be included on the site. They must all share the common principles of creating a fair and just society.**
- **The campaigns are then put into sections such as health, housing, politics, environment, family etc.**
- **Before you can post a request of your own you have to earn a given number of points by supporting other campaigns.**
- **If someone requests a number of RT on twitter then this is worth a given number of points. A blog post, design poster, attending a march, different numbers of points. Sliding scale.**
- **When you have sufficient points you can post up your own request and pay back your points to those who support you.**
- **It continues in this way – the more you support other campaigns the more support you can ask for.**

**This project would require full-time moderation/maintenance and this would have to be paid for from the fees. It would also require suitable software or bespoke design features. You would also need to check the law and have suitable disclaimers posted.**
